

RESOLUTION #2026-06

Whereas, the **Municipal Authority of the Borough of Bedford ("MABB")** provides treatment for the sanitary sewage collected by **Bedford Township Municipal Authority ("BTMA")**; and

Whereas, MABB is under a Consent Order and Agreement with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Environmental Protection ("DEP") to remove its combined sewer overflow ("CSO"); and

Whereas, in order to remove the CSO inflow and infiltration (I/I) must be removed from the sanitary sewer system including I/I from BTMA customers; and

Whereas, BTMA, in lawful session, duly assembled resolves as follows:

1. All property owners who are customers of BTMA shall be required to air pressure test all sanitary sewer laterals to assure that they are in compliance with the Rules and Regulations of BTMA. All tests shall be supervised by a designated employee of BTMA. Properties that pass shall be issued a Certificate of Compliance. Properties that fail shall have the sewer laterals repaired or replaced and shall be re-tested to ensure compliance.
2. To facilitate testing in the most effective and efficient manner, the BTMA engineer has submitted a plan to stage the testing by geographical areas giving consideration to the age of lines in an area and the likelihood of excessive I/I based on recent testing. The plan is approved.
3. BTMA Manager is authorized and directed to issue Notices to Test/Repair Sewer Laterals to customers in Phase 1 of the plan requiring testing to be completed by June 16, 2027, and that all work required as a result of a failed test be completed by December 16, 2027.

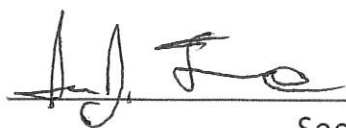
