Comments from Municipalities

- Coudersport Borough
 - Conducted a water audit, leak detection test, determined costs, and where the water goes as a project with DEP in January. All were conducted at no cost to the Borough.
- Genesee Township
 - Applied for the community block grant previously for the new water system
 - Currently the spring is detached from the system at the request of DEP
 - Genesee wants to try sand filtration or ultraviolet methods so they are able to use the spring.
 - The spring flow is three times the volume of the well.

• Monitoring Equipment Project

- Status
 - Monitoring equipment data collection continues.
 - Charlie is contacting Campbell Scientific in regards to equipment calibration and connecting Genesee to the data collection module.
